




Legality & Ethics

Burglar's tools; possession. Any person who shall knowingly have in his possession any nitroglycerine, or other explosive, thermite, engine, machine, tool or implement, device, chemical or substance, adapted and designed for cutting or burning through, forcing or breaking open any building, room, vault, safe or other depository, in order to steal therefrom any money or other property, knowing the same to be adapted and designed for the purpose aforesaid, with intent to use or employ the same for the purpose aforesaid, shall be guilty of a felony, punishable by imprisonment in the state prison not more than 10 years.



■ Pick




Two quick questions in preparation

- Where are the pins, on top or bottom?
- Which way does the barrel turn? Hint: clockwise :)

Lets do this!

- Insert the wrench and pick
- 2. Set the pin by turning the lock slightly
- 3. Maintain pressure
- 4. Rake the pins with your pick




Hey, I picked the padlock, now what?



Come Grab a Handcuff, key, and paperclip from the front


Handcuffs Parts

Key Image Here



Handcuffs have 2 locks

- The blue bar is pushed to the left to prevent the red bar from moving down to "double lock" the cuffs.
- The red bar (usually two pieces stacked)
 prevents the cuff from moving



Prepare your Paperclip

- bend the paperclip open
- 2. Insert in the keyhole
- 3. Bend the end of the paperclip using the hole for leverage



Lets do this!

- Insert paperclip in the keyhole
- 2. Rotate the paperclip counter-clockwise and push the blue bar to the right
- 3. Rotate the paperclip clockwise and push the red bar downwards
- 4. Pull the cuff open while the red bar is held out of the way
