Why Do I Write Tests First?

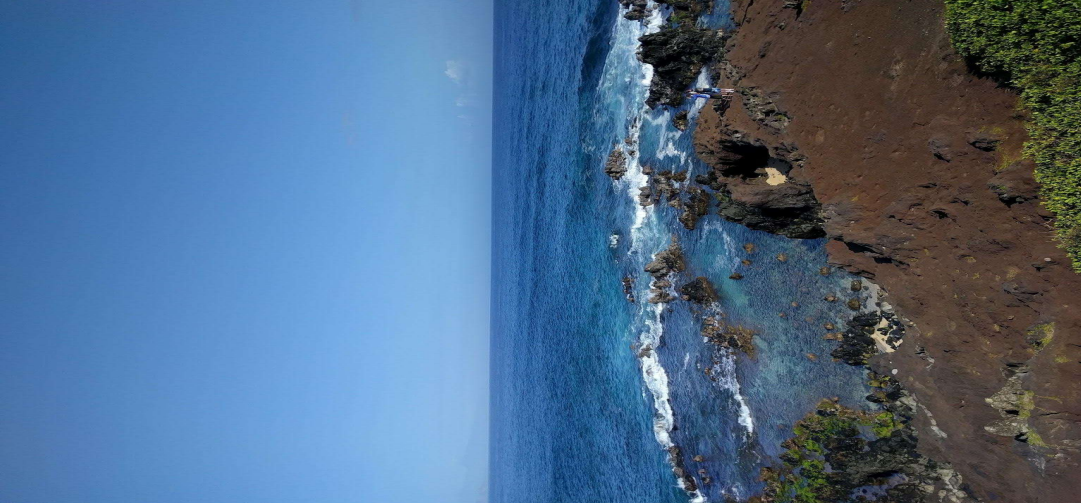

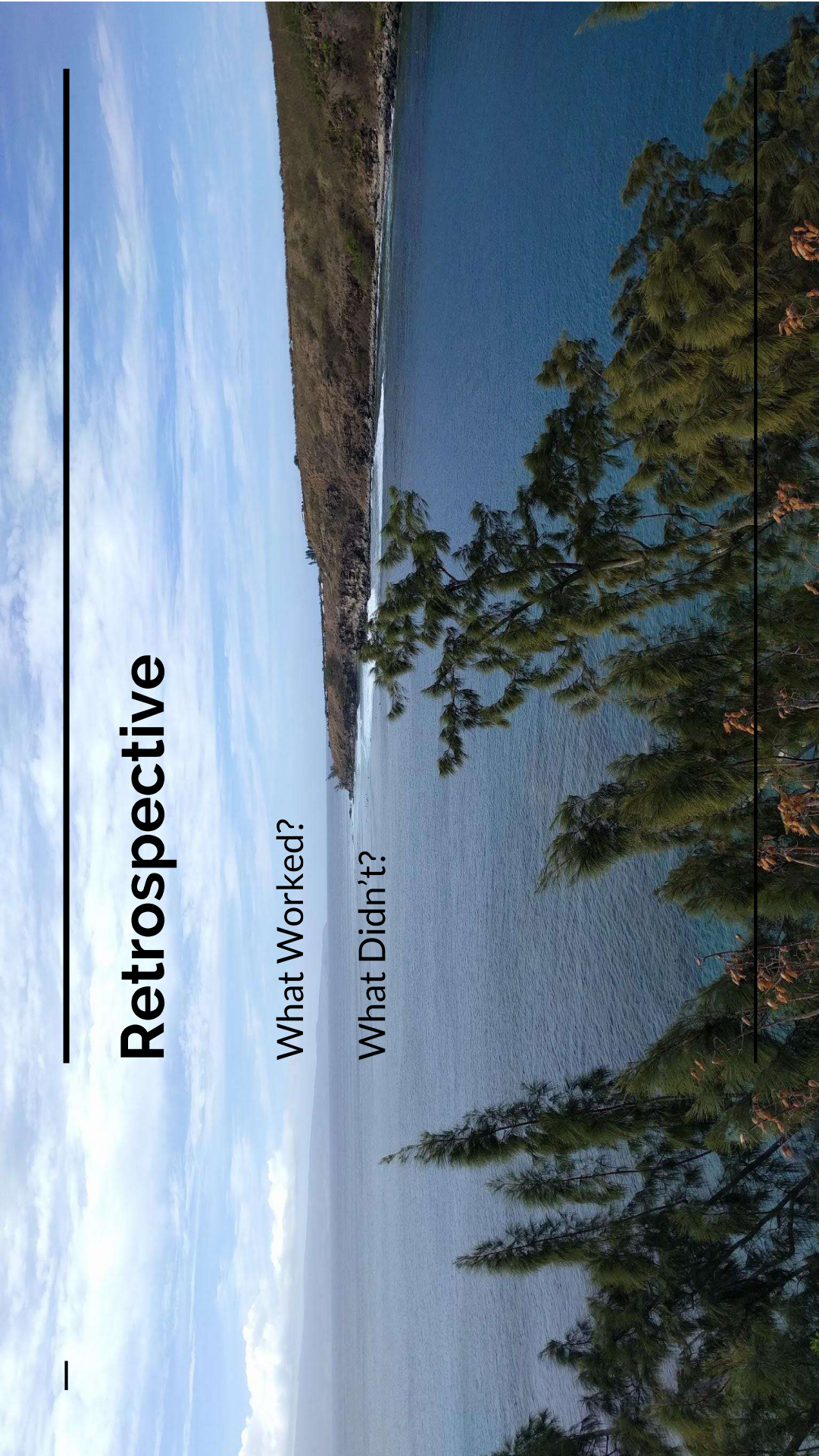
